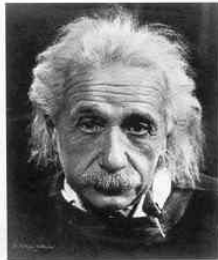


Support the Team that Works for You Join the UFF!
