

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES
AND
THE UNITED FACULTY OF FLORIDA – FACULTY UNIT

Non-Tenure Track Faculty Reclassification Project

WHEREAS, The Florida State University Board of Trustees (hereinafter “Board”) and the United Faculty of Florida (hereinafter “UFF”) are engaged in good faith collective bargaining;

WHEREAS, the Board and the UFF acknowledge progress in these negotiations but recognize that additional time and consideration is necessary involving both parties pertaining to the Non-tenure Track Faculty Reclassification Project;

WHEREAS, the Board and the UFF agree that it would be in the interest of Florida State University to move forward with working through the issues pertaining to the Non-tenure Track Faculty Reclassification Project so that it may be implemented;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is understood and agreed to the following:

A joint labor-management committee will be established no later than November 1, 2009, chaired by the Director of Faculty Relations and including up to one additional member of the administration and up to two members appointed by the UFF – FSU Faculty Unit with the goal of continuing to work toward an agreeable implementation of the Non-tenure Track Faculty Reclassification Project. The committee will present a proposed plan of action to the negotiation teams for negotiations in 2010.
